# Foreword

# THIS IS IMPORTANT — READ IT.

It is very necessary to-day that some information by way of a foreword should be given to those interested in the purchase of a new Bicycle — Firstly you should know the position we have held in the Industry over a long period — We are Lightweight specialists and ever since 1923, when we first introduced into England the modern upright design of Sports and Racing Bicycles as opposed to the then design of Bicycle Frames — — We are also producers of Lug Sets and particularly of Tandem Lug Sets which we have supplied in large quantities to Manufacturers all over the World — Furthermore we were responsible for the introduction of the modern Tandem, particularly in the Double Diamond type of Frame, and of the following — The staggered rear Seat Tube, which is important because it gives the rear rider a longer top tube and, therefore, a better riding position — The strutted bracket was another registered design of ours which again is incorporated when a Derailleur type Gear is used. We also introduced in 1923 the 70° head angle which has now come back to fashion and also the upright design frames of recent years.

If you know all these points then you will appreciate just how far we have been responsible for the popularity of the present modern Lightweight. Furthermore we believe we are the only actual Manufacturers of Bicycles, that is apart from Lightweight builders and assemblers, who build entirely to the customers specification if desired, and a special department is set aside especially for this.

SID PATTERSON. Congratulations to Sid on winning the World Professional Pursuit Championship in Paris this year and also on his magnificent riding in the Sprints on the Continent of Europe.

His Pursuit Race in the World Pursuit Championship in Paris was considered by many as the finest in the history of the World Championships — He also competed in nearly every final in the World Classic events during the season, but he considers his best win, apart from the Championship, was the Grand Prix D'Auteiul in Paris. His road machine, which he rides in training is produced to his own specification and bears his autographed signature transfer on the front down tube and the two models he rides are the Wasp Champion Du Monde track and the Sid Patterson Champion Du Monde road machine.

Apart from our successes on the track we have had a record number of successes in Road Championships throughout the World, having won the Malayan and Singapore Championships and many of our Bicycles were used, or are being used, by members of Olympic Teams of various countries throughout the World, and finally our remarkable success in the Tour of Britain when we won more stages than any other Bicycle and in final classification finished 2nd and 4th.

Frame Sets. We produce both our standard Frames and also Frames built to your specification, which can be ordered and supplied through any of our dealers who are also appointed official service dealers to this Company. World Championship Frames as used by Patterson and Tour of Britain Frames can be supplied.

**Tandems.** We are the largest Manufacturers of Tandems and Tandem Fittings in the World. Our designs are registered and these can be supplied almost immediately. Be sure that whatever Tandem you purchase you should insist on being supplied with a "Sun" Patent Coupled Heel Brake, this is for your especial safety.

New Models. Many improvements have been made in specification — Soleil D'or now supplied with 27 inch High Pressure Tyres and Wheels, or 26 inch. This now also applies to the Manxman.

# Sid Patterson

This model has been designed by Patterson and built to his specification—also used for Road training — autographed on front down tube.

Frame: Sizes 22", 23", 24". Built with Reynolds 531 tubing and special cutaway lugs, stays and forks 531. 73°×71° or 72!×71°.

Forks: Oval with "Sun" Cloverleaf cutaway crown, thin taper Reynolds 531 blades, with forged steel forkends, expander head fitting.

Tyres and Wheels: Dunlop 27" high pressure with B.H. special Patterson hubs. Spokes 15 × 17.

C/Wheel: 46T. flanged 3-pin detachable chainring, Williams.

Pedals: Solid centre sports or quill.

Saddle: This is a special saddle as used by Patterson, and supplied by Mansfield.

Mudguards: Celluloid or alloy.

Brakes: G.B. alloy hooded levers or "Sun."


Handlebars: Maes, alloy on "Sun" Wasp 2½ or 3" extension.

Gear: Fixed sprocket and freewheel supplied.

Pump: 18" alloy.




