Fitting very simple.


It operates even if cable breaks by symply disengaging spring 98.

It allows the use of freewheels with any number of cogs.

It stands up to rough usage and always maintains its perfomance.

Very fast and silent.

It latst for a long time owing to its accurate workmanship.



IMPORTANT NOTICE

BEFORE USING THE GEAR (particularly when changes the freewheels or the chainwheelring) IT IS NECESSARY:

1. Ensure that the gear is fitted in line with chainwheel and that screw 107 is strongly tight.

2. Be certain that the chain is long enough to allow using the largest chainwheelring with the largest freewheel cog.

3. To adjust the two screws 99 so that the chain cannot jump off from outside cogs of the freewheel when changing gear.

4. If the freewheel is too near to the spoker, fit the spacing ring 651 (pag. 19 of our catalogue nr. 12).

5. When dismounting the inner roller arm 92, be careful not to reassemble in a reverse position.

N.B. When cable breaks, the gear may still operate as well by disenganging spring 98.

To give more or less tension to the chain, remove spring end to another hole and tighten screw 506.
